RING CUSHION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Remove the ring cushion from the outer packaging.
- 2. Check that the cushion has a spare valve seat supplied (small black ring). Fig 1.
- 3. Unscrew the valve and check that there is a valve seat in the bottom of the valve.
- 4. Replace the valve plug, but DO NOT TIGHTEN
- 5. Gently separate the walls of the ring cushion, all the way round. This will make it easier to inflate. Fig. 2 & 3.
- 6. Inflate by mouth. Fig 4.
- 7. Tighten the valve plug.

Problem solving.

| Fault | Cause | Remedy |

| Cushion will not | Valve closed | Slacken valve and try again |
| inflate | Cushion walls stuck together | Separate walls and try again |
| Cushion deflates | Valve plug loose | Tighten |
| | Valve seat missing/damaged | Replace valve seat with spare |
| | Puncture | Return to supplier and purchase a |
| | | new cushion/exchange. |


